### Apples, apples, apples

Our orchard trees are absolutely laden - please pop in any time to harvest them - they make lovely apple crumble, apple pies and are great eating if you like tart apples! Great for chickens or pigs - the windfall apples.



### Easy Apple Pie

1 sheet of pre-rolled puff pastry. Cut into a circle. Sprinkle 2 tabs of flour on the pastry. Prepare apple slices apples with lemon juice, cinnamon and sugar. Place apples on top of the flour leaving a good 7 cms from the edge. Fold pastry over and brush with milk and sprinkle with raw sugar. Bake 200 until brown.
