Lamb, Calf & Pet Day

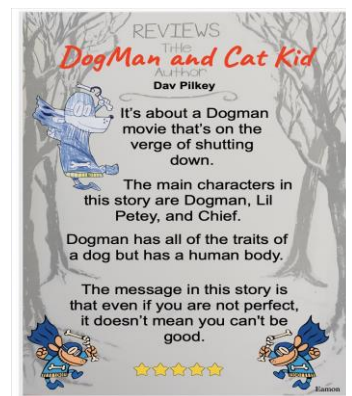
