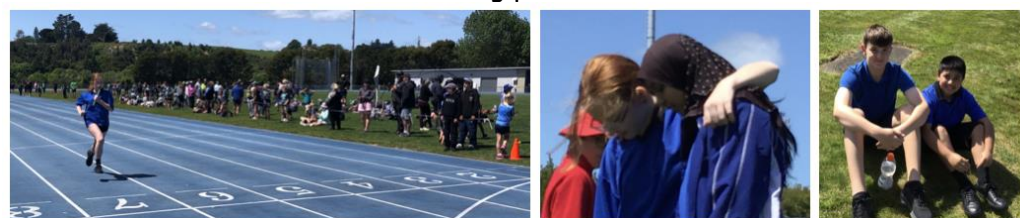
Colour Fun Run
