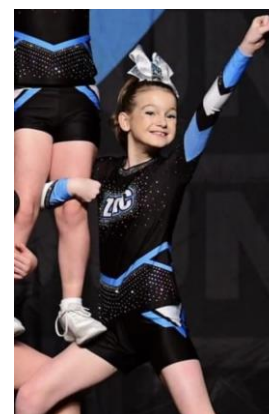
The exam will be later this term.

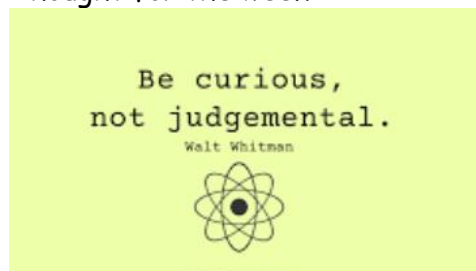
