Fantastic results in junior room.

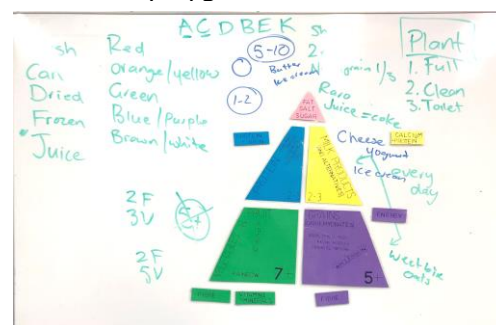
