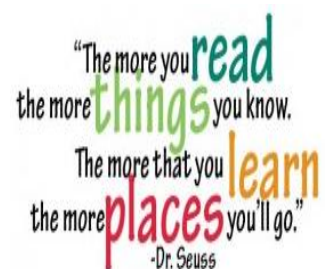
Welcome
