Swivel chairs, school desks, exercycle, wooden chairs (large and small) - yes, we're Spring cleaning!

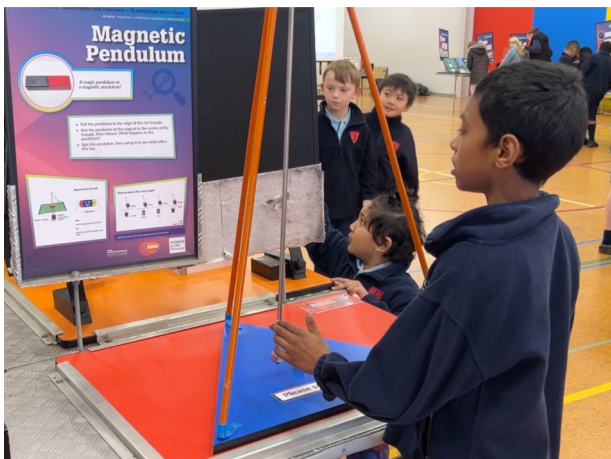
## End of term rewards trip

## Te reo online assessment for Y4-8

I am pleased to report that the seniors are improving their vocab, social interaction, cultural knowledge and language knowledge in te reo Maori. The online assessment that seniors have now completed show 3 students are achieving at Stage 2 and 5 are at Stage 1 using our Sanson School te reo Maori progressions. Learners have seen their reports and a copy has been provided for whanau.

Ka pai Tamara (moving from Stage 1 to Stage 2 and increasing her scaled score by 12 points since last being tested in 2021 and Hamzah for increasing his scaled score by 6 points). This is great baseline data for all seniors as only Tamara and Hamzah completed the assessment in 2021.
